Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your latest price catalogue, letter of Oct 10th, also extra lists, which I appreciate and hope will lead to business.

I also thank you for your remarks and sketch re connections for Motor-Generator & find that I had connected up exactly as shown, taking one coil directly from brush holder of generator, you will be pleased to hear the machine is giving every satisfaction.

I am at the present time negotiating for a ?????? 3 & 5 HP for a private hospital and hope to get the order in a week or two, several lines for lights and Xray work (coil being wound to 110 volts)

As steady voltage would be required I should think a Rotary converter would do, and as I may cable for the 3 HP one on your list, if order is delayed it would be well for you to keep these particulars.

I anticipate sending orders for general supplies early in the next year, and as the drought which has been on our "State" for the last seven years seems to have now broken, we are anticipating great revival of trade.
