I have lately placed into a Syndicate the whole of the rights of the London Synchronome Coy for Australiasia , and I feel sure that I can either induce them to take over your Patents or to be worked with the Synchronome Clocks throughout the States above named, or form another Syndicate to do so.

In the mean time I should like your advice and terms in confidence, at what you would sell these rights.

Possibly a working sample could be forwarded through Messrs Allison & Co. Gracechurch St, who are forwarding other goods to us. I presume that a commision, would be allowed me in the event of my selling your Patents favourably.
