Re the Time-Switch it is not absolutely essential that this should work with the Synchronome movement but if so fitted would save the necessity of winding, as a rule the actual time of cutting on or off need not be so exact. I have no doubt the sample coming to hand will meet every requirement, especially if the break is quick and long suitable for 550 Volts, as mentioned in my previous letter.

You will have received my letter and order of two weeks ago, which I hope you will have despatched quickly, in the event of it not having left you I would like enclosed sample of pocket Voltmeter for testing Motor Car cells, not high price, otherwise prices and particulars will suffice till next order.
