Dear Sir,

Re my Electric "Fire Alarm" of which the Patent Number is 14940, 1909. I authorize you to sell this in the State of Western Australia for any sum to allow me a minimum of (£50) Fifty pounds cash but I should think (£100) One hundred pounds to me would be a fair sale amount.

I have forwarded sample fitted with bell, battery, and switch to demonstrate its working.

In the event of your being able to sell the patent rights, I authorise you to place the sole agency and right to manufacture for one year on payment to me of (£20) Twenty Pounds with the option of further extension at same rate if Patent is not sold in the meantime.
